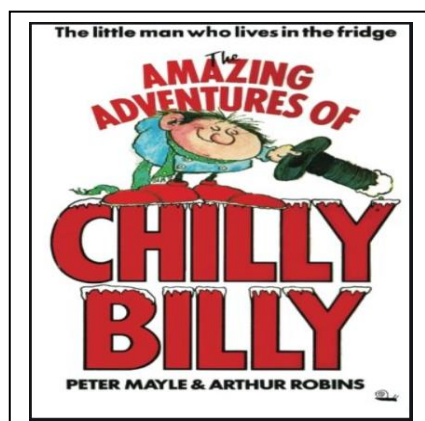
Thank you for your brilliant learning. I am so proud of you all. I will visit your academies/school to see you. Make sure you say hello!
